The Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at Stanford University School of Medicine is seeking a full-time faculty member in the Clinician Educator Line, at the rank of Clinical Assistant Professor, Clinical Associate Professor, or Clinical Professor, to conduct clinical care and teaching in geriatric psychiatry. The position will be based at the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences.

The chosen candidate will serve as an attending geriatric psychiatrist on the inpatient unit and provide clinical care in the outpatient geropsychiatry clinic. The candidate will also provide occasional coverage for the electroconvulsive therapy service. Major teaching responsibilities will be fulfilled as part of the regular clinical activities, and include supervision and didactics to medical students, residents, and fellows.

Applicants must have a medical degree or equivalent degree, completed training in General Psychiatry, possess or be fully eligible for a California medical license, and Board certified in General Psychiatry. In addition, applicants must also be Board certified in Geriatric Psychiatry, or Board eligible, by July of 2012.
