American College of Neuropsychopharmacology Associate Member Submission Procedures--2013*

*Membership becomes effective January 1, 2014

- ➤ A person whose career interest is in the field of neuropsychopharmacology, and who has demonstrated potential to become a superior investigator in this field may apply for associate membership status.
- Nominees may be no more than ten years beyond completion of training.

To be considered for Associate Membership in the ACNP, the nominee must:

- **Step 1: Complete required forms.** The required forms may be obtained on the ACNP website, acnp@acnp.org, or by clicking the link below. They are as follows:
 - Nomination Letter Template
 - Past Affiliations, Education and Awards
 - Publications
 - Grants and Patents
 - ACNP Activities
 - Role in Industry Projects
 - Reporting Requirements
 - **Step 2: Prepare required documents.** The requirements below must be gathered by the nominee and submitted as part of a complete nomination package. They are as follows:
 - **Papers -** Two relevant and **published or "in press" documents only** which most represents your major accomplishments in neuropsychopharmacology.
 - Letters from Nominators An individual must be nominated by two ACNP members. Each ACNP member may nominate only one candidate for Associate Membership each year. No more than one nominator can be from the same institution as the candidate. The nomination letters must be completed using the Nomination Letter Template and submitted with the nomination package. It is the nominee's responsibility to obtain the nomination letters prior to the September 18, 2013 deadline.
 - Abstracts Ten (10) complete abstracts which correspond to the titles listed on your Publications Form (see Step 1 above). Note: the 10 abstracts should be combined into one pdf for upload and should correspond to the order that they are listed on your Publications form.
 - **Unique author identification number -** a unique identifier that expressly associates you with your published works. To obtain an author identification number, go to the ResearcherID website: www.researcherid.com/SelfRegistration.action and add your first name, last name, and e-mail address where indicated. You will receive a ResearcherID invitation via e-mail that will walk you through the registration instructions.

Step 3: Submit Nomination Package On-line. To begin the submission process, go to:

- **Complete on-line information -** You will be asked to provide the following:
 - Personal and Professional Information
 - Number of publications
 - Unique Author Identification Number (see Step 2)
- ➤ Upload Required Forms and Documents There are ten (10) mandatory uploads which must be completed and submitted. All documents must be submitted in pdf format.

Late nominations or incomplete nomination packages will not be reviewed. All new membership additions will be discussed by the Membership Committee and recommended to Council during the 2013 ACNP Annual Meeting. New members will be announced at the ACNP Business Meeting on Wednesday, December 11th. All nominees will be notified by December 20, 2013.
