

## **FACULTY POSITION**

The **Department of Psychiatry at the University of Michigan Health System** is recruiting to a named, endowed tenure-track professorship at the associate professor rank or above to lead a clinical/translational research program in depression within the University of Michigan Department of Psychiatry and Comprehensive Depression Center. The successful candidate will have a well-defined program of research in depression, ideally integrating clinical and neurobiological research with clinical delivery systems. The applicant must have evidence of success in obtaining external funding and publishing their work in high-impact journals. Previous experience of working in a multi-disciplinary medical school setting and multi-center clinical trials is preferred. This position will closely interface with the extensive clinical and research activities within the Department of Psychiatry, and across the UM Medical School and university campus through the UM Comprehensive Depression Center. In addition, the candidate would be expected to join national collaborative work through the National Network of Depression Centers, a consortium of 21 centers at academic medical centers across the country, headquartered in Ann Arbor. Current department research strengths include sleep, neuroimaging, genetics, longitudinal studies in mood disorders, perinatal mental health and substance use disorders, and investigators collaborate freely with other departments in the medical school and university. The Department of Psychiatry also runs a brain stimulation program, providing clinical TMS and ECT, as well as ongoing research in TMS, ECT and deep brain stimulation. Primary responsibilities will include maintaining an active interdisciplinary research program integrated with clinical delivery, education and training activities. Other responsibilities will include leadership, facilitation and oversight of public policy advocacy, education, and depression training of interns, residents, post-docs, medical students and junior Applicants must hold MD/PhD or MD, PhD or equivalent. Compensation and a generous start-up package will be commensurate with qualifications and academic rank.
