**Assistant, Associate or Full Professor of Psychiatry, In Residence
Assistant, Associate or Full Professor of Clinical Psychiatry**

A full-time faculty position is available in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at the Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor level for a clinical researcher studying any area of child psychiatry. The candidate must possess an M.D. or equivalent, with formal training and demonstrated research expertise in child psychiatry. The applicant must be board certified in both general and child and adolescent psychiatry, licensed or license-eligible to practice medicine in California. Preferred experience supervising child and adolescent psychiatry residents/fellows, general psychiatry residents, and medical students.

The individual selected for the position will demonstrate evidence of a strong track record in an area of child psychiatry research (of particular interest: ADHD, disruptive and impulse control disorders, depression, anxiety, OCD, tic disorders), as reflected in publications, extramural funding, and presentations at national and international meetings. UC Davis is home to the MIND Institute, a collaborative interdisciplinary biomedical research center focused on neurodevelopmental disorders. A research area complementary to those studied at the MIND Institute is advantageous. The department will provide sufficient support to enable the selected candidate to establish a research program in the area of interest. The successful applicant will also demonstrate excellence in and a commitment to teaching and university service. Additional responsibilities include provision of clinical services relevant to diagnosis and/or treatment of infants, children, and/or adolescents. Additional responsibilities include interdisciplinary collaborations with faculty from diverse backgrounds and participation in team science initiatives relevant to child psychiatry.

Applications should be submitted by January 31, 2017 for initial consideration. However, the position will remain open until filled through June 30, 2017.
